Students are expected to arrive to school by the time indicated on the schedule, but will be welcome half an hour prior to any exam. The State Board of Regents states that late students be admitted into exams for the first 45 minutes but will not be provided any additional time to complete the exam. All students are required to remain in the exam room for the first hour of the test. Regents exams are 3 hours long. Students with extended time will take the exam in a separate location and will be allowed 4 1/2 hours for each regents.

Students need to bring 2 blue or black pens, a pencil and a calculator for the science and math exams.

Students who have completed the test can wait for friends in the cafeteria. We ask that students leave the floors where exams are being given as a courtesy to those still taking the test.
